Here is a list of items our shelter frequently needs and the shelter population your donation would serve.

Neonate Kittens/Newborn Orphan Kittens

1. Pet Nurser Bottles
2. Miracle Nipples
3. Baby Wipes
4. Breeder's Edge Foster Care Kitten Milk Replacement
5. Fleece blankets
6. K&H small animal heating pads
7. Distilled Water (for Incubator)

Adult Cats/Kittens

1. Treats
 - a. Friskies Party Mix (any flavor/variety)
 - b. Temptations (any flavor/variety)
2. For Sick Cats/Kittens
 - a. Sheeba perfect portions pate
 - b. Canned Tunafish
 - c. Friskies/9lives canned food
 - d. Fancy Feast canned food
 - e. Canned Chicken
 - f. Broth cat food
 - g. Weruva BFF canned food
 - h. Distilled Water (for humidifier)
 - i. Hard Sided Cat Travel Carriers
3. Toys
 - a. All sorts of cat toys!

Dogs

1. Training treats (any variety)
2. Milkbone small/medium (no large please!) or any milkbone products
3. Rice (for kongs)
4. Canned chicken
5. Tough Toys for large dogs

- a. Kong toys
 - b. Tuff toys
 - c. Prefer no nylabones
6. Martingale collars (large size only)
 7. 6 foot double handled leashes (no retractable leashes please)
 8. Plastic Frisbees (used for enrichment disks)
 9. Licky Mats

General

1. Lysol wipes (or other brand disinfectant wipes)
2. Kitchen cleaner (for food prep areas)
3. Paper towels
4. Snack/Quart/Gallon size Zip-top bags (for kongs/foster supplies)
5. Window/Glass Cleaner
6. Dawn Dish Soap (for general dishes & bathing baby animals)

Items we cannot accept:

1. "Well-loved" items- Pet items that have been loved past their prime. Unfortunately, these items are either not safe or cannot be sufficiently sanitized for kennel use in a multidog/cat environment. We ask that any items that are "well loved" be safely/properly discarded.
2. We cannot accept items that require repair, replacement parts or are more than 25% rusted (crates etc)
3. Like New items that are not pre-cleaned (ie used fleece blankets that have not been washed), toys that have dirt and litter embedded in them etc.
4. We cannot accept expired donated food- however, the local wildlife sanctuary usually can. They also usually accept open food!
5. We appreciate you thoroughly checking "like new" items before donating, so our staff is easily able to sort these items into their new homes for use.
6. If an item is not on the needed list, please do not donate it as it will most likely not be used.
